While staying since September '91 at the University of Pennsylvania:

Has developed and taught the following courses: *Business Russian I, Business Russian II, Political Russian* and *The Phenomenon of Soviet Propaganda*. *The Phenomenon of Soviet Propaganda* is taught through CGS. He has 15 students in this course, three of them coming from Bryn Mawr College.

The Consortium for Language Teaching and Learning funded his Campus-Based Project aimed at developing teaching materials for Political Russian.

He has initiated the first Penn Summer Program in Kiev and will be coordinating it in June '93.
