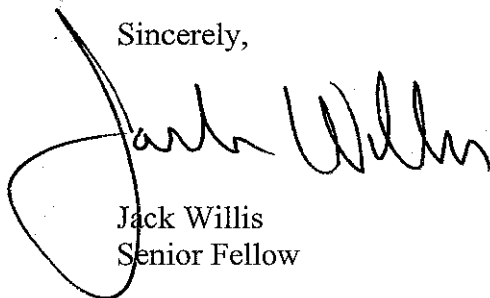
Dear George,

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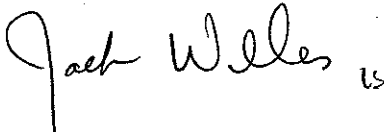

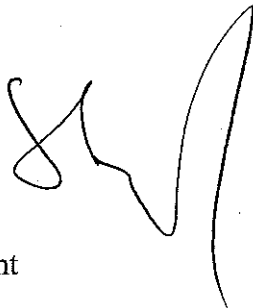
1. Complete supporting documentation; each expenditure is supported by an original receipt that clearly indicates the purpose of the expense, and the nature of the expense.

4. Open Society Institute considers \$25 for breakfast, \$25 for lunch and \$50 for dinner reasonable costs. We will not reimburse you for the cost of movie rentals or phone calls.

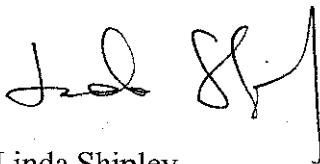
