>Paciffica has hired a uniformed, unarmed 24 hour security guard at  
>the cost of \$360.00 per day, KPFA News reported today. The  
>guard is stationed in the KPFA lobby.

>An unconfirmed rumour, that Pacific has hired an executive search  
>firm to find a replacement for Sawaya. Tens of thousands of dollars  
>were spent earlier in the search for an Executive Director. Lynn  
>Chadwick was hired (she however was not hired as a result of this  
>search. It is unclear exactly what they were searching for; at that  
>time Marty Durlin, Manager of KGNU in Boulder sent a resume;  
>though her resume was received she said she never received a  
>letter acknowledging her application. Marty Durlin is known for her  
>staunch advocacy of community based radio, and her opposition to  
>the Healthy Station Project. She is a co-founder of the Grass  
>Roots Radio Coalition, formed 4 years ago in response to Lynn  
>Chadwick's administration at the NFCB.
