



Foundation for Global Community (successor to Beyond War) is a non-profit educational organization, headquartered in Palo Alto, California. The focus of the Foundation is its recently established Center for the Evolution of Culture. The Center's mission: *to contribute to a transformation of cultural values, a transformation from the dominant culture of growth, of more, of materialism, to a culture of enough, of quality and excellence, of spirit; a culture which works for the diversity of life.*

The Center's work includes courses, production of educational videos, lectures at its Palo Alto facility, and seminars at the Foundation's Sequoia Seminar retreat center in the Santa Cruz Mountains. Programs include individual participation, collaborative efforts, and concerted social action.

Current video, audio, and printed materials are described in our catalog. The bimonthly publication of the Foundation is called *Timeline*.

The work of the Foundation spans half a century, involving individual spiritual growth, social action, grassroots education, and mediation of international conflicts. It is perhaps best known on the international scene for its annual Beyond War Awards (1983-1990), which reached millions of people worldwide through global satellite coverage.
