

ANGRY CHARACTER

1. SUMMARY What does the angry character do in the anger scene(s) which he/she is involved?

2. HUMANITY

- 0 = cannot code
- 1 = human
- 2 = humanized animal, machine, thing or creature
- 3 = nonhumanized animal, machine, thing or creature

3. GENDER Code for the character's gender

- 0 = cannot code (explain)
- 1 = male
- 2 = female

4. SOCIAL AGE What is the character's social age?

- 0 = cannot code, various ages, ageless (explain)
- 1 = pre-adolescent and adolescent period
- 2 = young adult
- 3 = settled adult
- 4 = old, elderly

5. RACE Code for real human races only.

- 0 = cannot code
- 1 = white
- 2 = African American
- 3 = Asian (includes Pacific islands)
- 4 = Indian (American)
- 5 = other (write in)

6. ROLE What's the character's role in the program?

- 0 = cannot code
- 1 = good, hero, positive
- 2 = mixed, unclear
- 3 = bad, villain, negative

Use the following codes for items #7-15:

- 0 = cannot code, unclear (explain)
- 1 = yes
- 2 = no

7. DRUGS Does the character use or take illegal drugs (other than prescription and over the counter)?

8. ALCOHOL Does the character drink alcohol?
9. POSSESS WEAPON Does the character possess a weapon?
10. VIOLENT Does the character become violent as a result of his/her anger?
11. VERBALLY ABUSIVE Does the character verbally abuse another character because of his/her anger? (definition: insults, deriding of character, teasing)
12. WITHDRAWN Does the character become withdrawn as a result of his/her anger (alienates him/herself from other characters)?
13. RACIST Does the character use racist overtones because of his/her anger?
14. SEXIST Does the character use sexist overtones as a result of his/her anger?
15. THREAT Does character threaten to harm target of his/her anger?
