Dear George, Victoria, and Charlie::

It was good talking with you and the others. As promised, here are the following:

1. Raffi. As I said, I spoke with him and he remembers you George and expressed interest, but of course needs to know more. Please fax him information on CEM and the conference. The fax is 604-682-4291.
2. Investments: There are many funds. I like the Domini Index funds. They have done extremely well, better than many conventional funds. My suggestion would be to still keep the safe government paper, etc. as well as perhaps more liquid funds, as we may need them for the conference and don't want to have to sell should we need funds while the market is down, but instead of conventional funds use Domini Index. I am not an investment advisor, nor do I claim any expertise, but this seems sensible to me, and also, as I said, investing in socially responsible funds is more congruent with our mission and aligns us with the socially responsible business community and their organizations.
3. On the contract, I am afraid we went around in circles a bit. My concern remains that since CEM is legally responsible for the use of the funds from the grantor because they go through us, the agreement should more clearly reflect that we are to be indemnified in that specific connection and not just have a general all purpose statement (which is fine, but not specific). I believe Gene said he would look at this.

5. When you get a chance, George and Victoria, let us talk about the conference theme as well as the issue Rose raised, which I think needs to be addressed either directly or indirectly.
