The Cultural Environment Movement conference on Media Antitrust is just two short weeks away on January 23-25, 1998. Enclosed are a few preparatory documents, including the expected agenda, a list of people attending, and directions to Sugarloaf Conference Center in Philadelphia.

We have tried to give the agenda enough rigidity to keep the conference focused, and enough flexibility to allow for changes in time and structure. There are places for mid-conference evaluation at which point we may change the agenda somewhat. To maximize the time we have together, most of the conference has been dedicated to dialogue and question/answer sessions (in which everyone asks and everyone can answer). All dialogue sessions will be moderated by Mark Crispin Miller.

We believe the combination of inspiring and thoughtful people attending the Conference makes it possible to leave on Sunday with a working plan for legal recourse to the media monopoly.
