Hi George-

After talking with you about your arrival in Oakland rather than in San Francisco, I tried my very best to change the location for the interviews on January 20th -- but, alas, could not. So here is the information.

Date: Tuesday, January 20
Time: 11:00 am
Place: Western Public Radio studios
Building 'D' at Fort Mason at the norther tip of SF.

You will be interviewed first by Julie Light for "Making Contact"- Then by Michael Phillips for his show, "Social Thought" Both interviews will be taped for future airing, not live. You will certainly be done with both interviews by 12:30 or 1:00 at the very latest.

Michael has kindly offered to take you wherever you need to go in San Francisco after his interview with you is finished, or to take you to the rapid transit station, BART, if you want to head off to the East Bay.

You should have plenty of time to get to the studios -- even given the usual expected problems connected to airline schedules and SF commuter traffic.

I am not familiar with the Oakland airport, but am told that the easiest transportation might be to take one of the shuttles into downtown SF and then a taxi out to Fort Mason. Or another possibility is to take a bus to the BART station, take BART to downtown SF, then a taxi to Ft. Mason. Check at the airport or with your travel agent for more, and more reliable information.

As I mentioned to you, I am sending you a map of the area. I will also include some information on our program "Making Contact" so you will have a sense of what we are doing.

I wish I was going to be here to have a chance to talk with you myself, but I will be in DC.
