> Union Station, you can either take a taxi or Metrorail. A Metrorail

> Shady Grove (the train itself may say Grosvenor). Get off at the Metro
> Center station and change to the Orange Line headed toward Vienna. Get
> off at the Ballston-Marymount University station. Exit the station at the
> corner of Fairfax Drive (the main street) and North Stuart Drive. Walk
> 1-1/2 short blocks down North Stuart Drive in the direction of the Hecht's
> store. The side entrance to NSF will be on your left. Just inside is the
> visitor information center.
