We would like that you develop a presentation (twenty minutes) on the nature of effects of violence on television on children. You're the «father» of this field of study. What would you like to say to participants of a colloquium on this issue in an original paper? As you will see in the programme, you will be matched with Dr. Cantor. Your two papers (she will write on the nature of the effects of violence on television on children) should be the start for a very good discussion.

Our plans are that I should get a copy of your paper (15 pages long plus Tables, Figures, Appendices and Bibliography, double space) by March 20th. We will make sure that everything is right and hopefully be able to publish the Colloquium Proceedings soon after the event. (The Proceedings will be marketed worldwide by the Centre d'études sur les médias).

You should travel to Montreal on April 18 (or 17) and make possible to attend the Town Hall meeting (see programme). You will be speaking in the afternoon of the 19. The Colloquium should end around 17:00. Since you will probably be flying back home on the 20th, we will organize a nice dinner in downtown Montreal. I promise that you will have a good time!

You will be paid an honorarium of \$ 1 500 CDN for your paper and for your participation during the colloquium. All your travel expenses for attending the Colloquium will be reimbursed by the Centre d'études sur les médias.
