We are writing to invite you to a conference intended to bring together leading senior scholars, critics and artists for one weekend (October 2-3, 1999) at UCSD to discuss the complex issues involved in the contemporary political economy of communications media. The conference is titled "Media and Communication in the New Global Economy" and is being held in honor of Professor Herbert Schiller's eightieth birthday.

We would like you to speak for 30-40 minutes on a topic related to the conference theme, while a UCSD faculty member will respond and lead discussion for 10 minutes. Presentations could take the form of reading position papers, presenting research or discussing case studies, or screening creative work.

Speakers are encouraged to present policy position papers, present research on the social impacts of new media technologies, or analyze the political economy of the converging entertainment, computer, telecommunications industries. Other topics might include the changing means of media distribution, the state of funding for independent media artists, and the possibilities and restrictions to access to new media and the Internet. Finally, we welcome papers on the widening gap between the so-called information rich and information poor, the circumstances of computer and electronics manufacturing, and their racialized and gendered workforce.

The conference is being funded by a grant from the UCSD Chancellor's Associates. At this point we offer travel, lodging and all expenses. As our fundraising efforts continue through the summer we hope to include an honorarium for conference speakers. We would like to collect the papers in a conference volume to be published through an arrangement with Herbert Schiller's agent, Sandy Dykstra. Details about the proposed edited volume will be forthcoming this summer.
