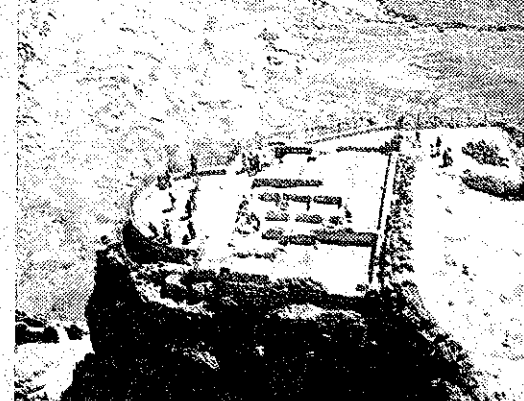

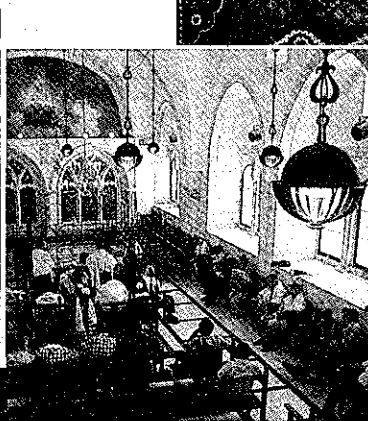
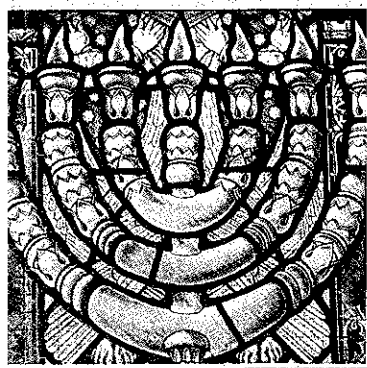

### General Conditions

**REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT:** A deposit of \$200. per person is required at time of booking. Balance of payment is due 60 days prior to departure.

**AIR TRANSPORTATION:** Round-trip from New York via jet economy class on EL AL AIRLINES or any IATA carrier. Published travel package "E" is based on the 6/75 Day Individual Excursion airfare of \$998. from JFK. Packages "A", "B", "C" and "D" are based on the 55/60 Superstar airfare from New York at \$697. Superstar airfares must be paid for no later than 14 days prior to commencement of travel. If cancellation is effected by the passenger within 14 days prior to commencement of travel, either 10% or \$50. (whichever is greater) of the airfare is subject to forfeiture.

All airfares are based on tariffs and regulations of airlines in effect at the time of printing this brochure, December 15, 1981 and are subject to change.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Run-of-the-house twin-bedded rooms with private bath or shower in government rated 5 Star, 4 Star and 3 Star Hotels depending on hotel plan selected by the participant. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at time of booking at supplements published in this brochure.

**MEALS:** Full Israeli breakfast daily on all hotel plans; Continental breakfast in Vienna.

**TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE:** All travel programs include round-trip motorcoach transfers from/to Hotel/Airport in Israel and Europe. Porterage of 2 pieces of luggage at airports and hotels in Israel and Europe is also included only when passenger utilizes our blocked air and land space.

**SIGHTSEEING AND ENTRANCE FEES:** All sightseeing as per itinerary aboard a private motorcoach with the services of a Government licensed English speaking guide. Entrance fees to sights visited are also included.

**BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE:** A maximum of 2 pieces of luggage per person with a combined length, width and height of 106 inches will be carried round trip without charge to Israel and from most other points of return to the U.S.A. However passengers on European extensions are permitted a total of 44 pounds (20 kilos) on the return leg plan of Vienna/New York.

**SERVICE CHARGES AND LOCAL TAXES:** All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in program rates.

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** A full refund will be given for cancellations received in writing up to one month prior to departure. Cancellations received within one month of departure will be subject to a handling fee of \$50.00 per person on the land portion as well as regulations governing airfares as set forth by the air carriers involved.

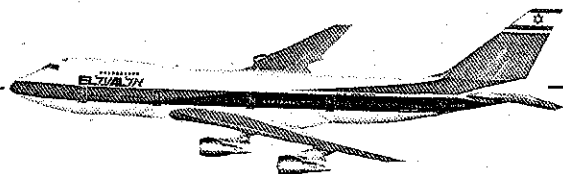
