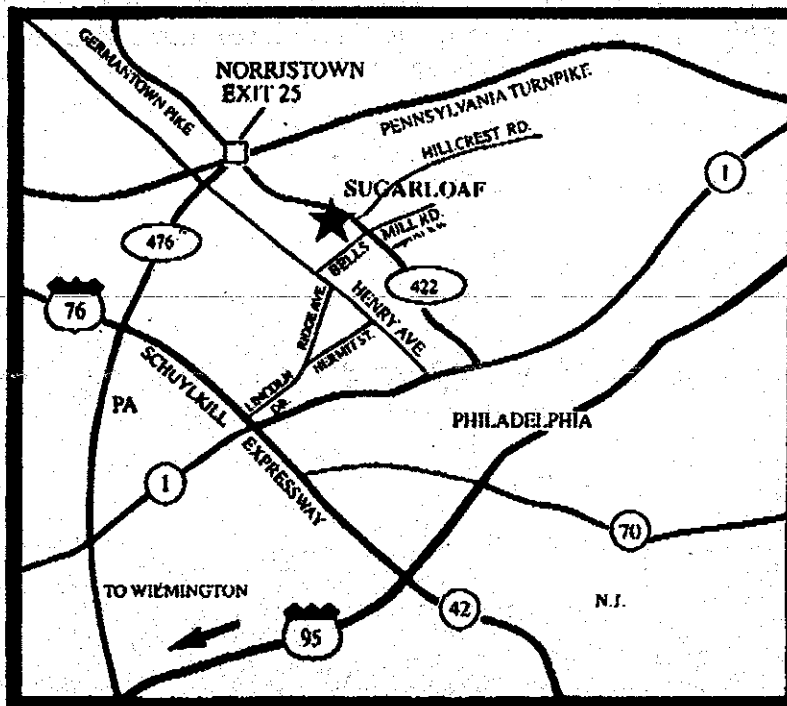

**FROM THE PA TURNPIKE:** Go to Norristown (Exit #25). Take Germantown Pike East to Philadelphia approximately 4 1/2 miles to Bells Mill Road and Germantown Avenue. Driveway for the Center is on the right twenty-five feet before the intersection.

**FROM THE NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE:** Go to Pennsylvania Turnpike. Follow directions above for Pennsylvania Turnpike.

**FROM SCHUYLKILL EXPRESSWAY (Route 76):** Exit at Lincoln Drive. Bear right to Ridge West Follow to top of hill (four lights) - cross straight. This is Hermit Street. Proceed on Hermit 1/4 mile to Henry Avenue. Turn left on Henry/Ridge and proceed 3.8 miles to Bells Mill Road. Turn right onto Bells Mill. Sugarloaf is at intersection of Bells Mill and Germantown Avenue.

**FROM PHILADELPHIA AIRPORT:** Cabs and limos will probably take the Schuylkill Expressway and Lincoln Drive to our location. Car rentals should follow Route 95 South from the airport and then Route 476 North to Plymouth Meeting. Take a right on Germantown Pike for almost 5 miles. Sugarloaf (just beyond Chestnut Hill College) has right-turn entrance at the intersection of Germantown Avenue and Bells Mill Road.

**FROM 309 EXPRESSWAY:** Exit at Papermill Road. Follow to the intersection of Stenton Avenue and Bethlehem Pike. Go straight through the intersection. Go around small curve to the street light (Hillcrest Road). Make a left. Follow to next light (Germantown Avenue). Make a left. Follow Germantown Avenue. Make a right into our driveway before the light at Bells Mill Road.

**BY TRAIN:** Amtrak Service from all points to Philadelphia. At 30th Street Station take Septa Railroad (Chestnut Hill West Local) to last stop (Chestnut Hill West Station) which is 1/2 mile from Centers. Take a taxi (572-6100) or walk to Centers.

**TAXIS:** Arrangements for ground transportation can be coordinated through Sugarloaf Conference Center.
