Please do not sign your name or indicate who you are on the "Commentary to Author" form; all submissions and evaluations are carried out through a "blind review" process.

If extended blocks of more than two weeks emerge when you cannot receive essays, please drop me a brief note. If you have already specified dates when you cannot receive essays, I will respect these dates.

If you are able and want to receive and/or respond to CQ essays by a computer-modem-telephone transmission at your home or your institution, please send me details on the procedure (days, times, etc.) you would like to use.

Again, I am pleased you are serving on the Editorial Board of CQ.
