Dave:

We all make mistakes (I am the only exception in the entire world!). Bottom line: I withdraw my request.

The problem is that once we turn the academy into a political arena, we bring all kinds of troubles. Whatever side we take, we alienate someone. That may be administrators, students, members of the public who are otherwise supportive of our institution, legislators who despise a position, and so on.

Perhaps even more important, a senior scholar has a responsibility to those more junior--as in the tenure line. If you espouse a political position publically, and a junior faculty member seeking your approval for tenure learns of this, what is he or she to do? Must that person take on your biases, whatever they are?

A university, functioning in its best traditions, is a place of learning, accumulating new knowledge, passing on that knowledge to others through teaching and publication. Once it become an arena of political activism, it runs into what we see in Latin America and other countries where institutions often suffer greatly as they lose the support of many. Us old farts who lived through McCarthyism, the upheavals re the war in VietNam and other political upheavals over a couple of decades, have some very bitter memories of what happens when an institution is politicized. I was at WSU during the period, and it was no fun at all.

OK, lecture is over. Put me back on your list.
