Dear Professor Moles:

Thank you very much for your letter of May 11. The item for INTERCOM will be in the Fall 1974 issue.

The criterion for the final selection of the first list of Consulting and Contributing Editors was -- chance. Each member on that board had definite term of service, and then others will be asked. In that way I hope that all the leading scholars in every active center of research in communication will be invited to serve over a period of say 5 to 7 years.

Most of our articles deal with empirical or theoretical communications research (or, preferably, both) focused on some issue of theory or policy. Manuscripts are sent out to experts in the field for review and comments before publication. We hope to carry articles in languages other than English, with a brief (3 to 5 paragraph) English summary. You are most welcome to submit a manuscript either in French or in English representing a significant contribution to knowledge or a challenge to some existing assumptions.

Incidentally, your book on La Communication: Et Les Mass Media is out to a reviewer and I hope to receive the review within a few months.

I hope to hear from you soon.
